Looking to Jesus

- 1. Psalm 27:8 (NIV) "When You said, "Seek My face," my heart said to You, "Your face, Lord, I will seek."
- 2. Psalm 34:5 (NIV) They looked to Him and were radiant, and their faces were not ashamed.
- 3. Jeremiah 29:13 (NKJV) And you will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the Lord, and I will bring you back from your captivity.
- 4. Hebrews 12:1-2 (NIV) Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.

- 5. Psalm 27:5 (NKJV) For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in the His pavilion. In the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me. He shall set me high upon a rock.
- 6. Psalm 32:7 (NKJV) You are my hiding place, You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance.
- 7. Isaíah 54:4 (NKJV) Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed; neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame.
- 8. Isaiah 54:5 (NKJV) For your Maker is your husband. The Lord of Hosts is His name, and your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel. He is called the God of the whole earth.
- 9. Isaiah 54:10 (NKJV) "For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart from you, nor shall My covenant of peace be removed," says the Lord, who has mercy on you.
- 10. Psalm 103: 2-5 (NKJV) Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all of His benefits, who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, who satisfies your mouth will good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

- 11. Psalm 91:1-2 (NKJV) He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God in Him I will trust."
- 12. Psalm 3:3 (ESV) But you, O Lord, are a shield about me, my glory, and the lifter of my head.

- 13. Isaíah 43:1 (NKJV) Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; you are Míne.
- 14. Isaíah 43:4 (NKJV) Sínce you were precious in My síght, you have been honored and I have loved you.
- 15. Song of Songs 2:14 (NKJV) O my dove, in the clefts of the rock, in the secret places of the cliff, let me see your face, let me hear your voice; for your voice is sweet, and your face is lovely.
- 16. 2 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV) Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is there is liberty. But we all with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 17. 1 John 3:1 (NIV) See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!

- 18. Isaíah 43:18-20 (NKJV) Do not remember the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold I will do a new thing. Now it shall spring forth; shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the dessert.
- 19. Psalm 27:14 (NKJV) Wait on the Lord; be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart; wait, I say on the Lord!
- 20. Isaíah 30:18 (NKJV) Therefore the Lord will wait that He may be gracious to you and therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you. For the Lord is a God of Justice. Blessed are those who wait for Him.

- 23. Hebrews 6:19 (NASB) This hope we have as an anchor for the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast.
